 Critical Target #1: Lutheran High School will enroll 400 students by June 2019. Steps taken to address this target: Hosted four Future Cougar Nights for elementary school students during the Fall season. Welcomed 110 visitors on campus for the annual Future Freshman Day on October 7. Purchased an integration tool to synthesize Enrollment & the School Information System. 	 Critical Target #2: The average ACT score of Lutheran High School's class of 2019 will be 26. Steps taken to address this target: Accepted nine sophomores into the Cougar Honors Academy. Arranged for on-site ACT tutoring for interested students beginning in October 2016. Provided ongoing faculty professional development on best practices regarding student assessment.
 Critical Target #3: Lutheran High School will update the funding model to ensure a cost manageable by the Association by June 2019. Steps taken to address this target: The Booster Club started implementing plans to accomplish its purpose of supporting LHS. Began developing relationships with local businesses to advance the LHS ministry. Started year four of five years with the church assessment plan. 	 Critical Target #4: Lutheran High School will improve the campus to provide an innovative environment by June 2019. Steps taken to address this target: Completed the refurbishing of Room 202 as a model for other classrooms. The Board passed an action proceeding with site due diligence to continuing assessing future plant needs. Met with architects as part of the due diligence plan and prioritized 4 areas: Increase student capacity by 100+ students Provide a better student commons space and include a dedicated cafeteria Provide a larger gym to hold 1,000+ spectators Create an updated image of LHS to the area
