Technology Safety Guidelines for Athletic Events

Lockers are the property of Lutheran High School. Students assume full responsibility for all items stored in the school locker and/or the locker room. Items of significant monetary value should not be stored in the locker room. LHS is not responsible for loss or damage to any items stored in the school locker or the locker room (AUP advises that they are not allowed in the locker room at any time.)

Guidelines for Securing Valuables Before, During, and After Athletic Contests

1. During practices and/or home games, do not bring your iPad into the locker room. The iPad is not meant to be stored in that environment. Lock it up in your school locker.
2. When you leave the iPad secured in your school locker, it is your responsibility to keep the locker door closed and locked and to not share your combination number with anyone. Again, students are expected to assume full responsibility for the security of their lockers.
3. During away games, you may either leave your iPad in your school locker or take it with you to the contest.
4. Each coaching staff will have a procedure in place if you *need* take the iPad with you to the away contest (LHS does not recommend this). Options include, but are not limited to: giving the iPad to the coaching staff/parent/student manager and having a “valuables” bag to store your iPad during the game and then return it to you following the contest, give it to your parents upon their arriving at the contest, leave it in the visiting locker room, etc. Again, there is no “one-size-fits-all” for every program.
5. If you take it with you to a contest someone will be on the LHS campus until 10:00 pm to let you into the building and obtain the items that you need from your locker for your studies.

Remember, LHS is not responsible for any theft, loss, damage or harm to the items in the school locker.
