First and foremost, we cling to the cross and the forgiveness that can only come from a belief in Christ crucified on our behalf. We also continue to stay grounded in the mission of Lutheran High. This update is to keep all involved and interested in the ministry of Lutheran High School. Our goal is to regularly update you on efforts and the direction of Lutheran High.

These targets are aggressive and big. At the same time, we have a BIG God! Our goals need to reflect the power of our God! We know that all things are possible through Him, and through Him, and His grace, we will hit our targets! The following is a summary of actions that have taken place since the last update.



Students from the Class of 2019 who were selected for the Cougar Honors Academy.

Critical Target #1:

Lutheran High School will enroll 400 students by June 2019.

Steps taken to address this target:

- Implemented an **online enrollment application** through PowerSchool for 2017-2018.
- Welcomed **43 student shadows** during the first semester, include 26 community students (an increase of 11 students from this time last year).
- Coordinate with **K-8 Junior Cougar teams** in the areas of football, softball, wrestling and Robotics.

Critical Target #2:

The average ACT score of Lutheran High School's class of 2019 will be 26.

Steps taken to address this target:

- Accepted first group of sophomores into the **Cougar Honors Academy**.
- Began the **curriculum review process** in the areas of theology and social studies.
- **Professional Learning Communities (PLCs)** are exploring instructional methods to provide students with test taking strategies to maximize their performance on tests.

Critical Target #3:

Lutheran High School will update the funding model to ensure a cost manageable by the Association by June 2019.

Steps taken to address this target:

- Exceeded the **Trivia Night** goal of \$15,000 by almost 20%.
- Received a **\$10,000 grant** towards tuition assistance for students interested in the area of STEM.
- Began process of hiring a **Director of Events**.

Critical Target #4:

Lutheran High School will improve the campus to provide an innovative environment by June 2019.

Steps taken to address this target:

- Renovated the **Commons restrooms**.
- Increased the number of data points and **bandwidth capacity** on campus.
- Presented a draft to the **Planning/Building Committee**, Board, and staff showing a plan for potential space based on student needs.
