**APRIL 26: Junior and Senior Prom:** This year's prom is being held at Bogey Hills Country Club. Prom occurs from 6pm-10pm. Doors open at 6pm with appetizers and soft drinks, at 6:30pm dinner is served. The dance will go from 7pm-10pm. All students are to be checked in by 7pm and can leave no sooner that 9pm. Tickets will be able to be purchased online for \$65. Prom is for Juniors and Seniors only, no underclassmen allowed. The Junior Class has sent out invitations to all Juniors and Seniors. April 26 will be a professional development day for faculty and staff, there will be NO CLASSES on April 26.

April 29: Senior Skip Day: Seniors are not to be on campus this day. It is an official "skip" day for seniors.

MAY 8: Senior Breakfast: Parents are encouraged to join their senior for our Senior Breakfast. Breakfast will be hosted in the Commons, doors open at 8am and the program will conclude with chapel from 9:45-10:10am.

MAY 9: Senior Awards Night: All seniors and their parents are encouraged to attend this special evening when all seniors will be recognized for their academic accomplishments. Doors open at 6:00pm and the program begins at 6:30pm in the Commons. Students are asked to please dress-up for the awards night.

MAY 9-MAY 27 Senior Banner: A large congratulatory banner will be hung on the stadium fence. Please feel free to stop by and take pictures with your senior.

MAY 21 Graduation Rehearsal: All seniors are required to be present in the school gym from 11:30am-12:30pm for graduation rehearsal. At this time, students will pick-up their cap and gown, and verify that all outstanding balances and school materials (athletic uniforms, textbooks, etc.) have been turned in. Graduation gowns should be hung and lightly misted or steamed to remove wrinkles prior to the ceremony. Students may not decorate graduation caps. A separate email regarding payment for the \$80 graduation fee will be sent in the coming days.

MAY 26 Graduation: Graduation will be held in the LHS gym, seating is limited to a maximum of 8 guests per senior. Tickets will be issued at graduation rehearsal. If families need additional tickets, they are encouraged to contact other families that may not be using all 8 tickets. Graduation begins at 3pm, doors open at 2pm. At graduation, all seniors will receive an empty diploma cover as they walk across the stage. Paper diplomas will be mailed to all students following graduation, once all credits and fees have been finalized.
